The 33-year old pop/rock sensation has returned from maternity leave – her daughter, Willow, is now one-year old – to drop *The Truth About Love*, her brash-as-ever new album. And her over-the-top performance of “Blow Me (One Last Kiss)” on the 2012 MTV Video Music Awards – featuring black sequin shorts, fishnet tights and high-flying acrobatics – proved that motherhood has not softened her badass style.
